


A Cut-Out Toy—Polly, the Parrot—By Dan Rudolph

CUT SLIT ON DOTTED LINE, INSERT LOWER TIP OF WING FROM THE BACK AND DRAW DOWN TO POSITION, AFTER WHICH, PUT PIN THROUGH THIS DOT AND DOT ON WING



CUT OUT

PIN HERE AND DOT NO. 1 ON LOWER BEAK

LOWER BEAK

PIN HERE AND LOWER DOT ON RIGHT FOOT

PIN HERE AND DOT ON FOOT ON LIMB

POLLY'S LEFT FOOT

FROM UPPER TAB ON WING TO UPPER DOT ON LIMB


FROM UPPER DOT ON RIGHT FOOT TO SECOND DOT ON LIMB

FROM LOWER TAB ON WING TO DOT NO. 2 ON LOWER BEAK

Polly the Pet Parrot

BACK-VIEW DIAGRAM

SHOWING HOW THE TOY SHOULD BE PINNED TOGETHER. IN REPOSE, OR WHEN POLLY SITS UP STRAIGHT, YOU WILL NOTE THAT HE IS FAST ASLEEP BUT, GRASP HIM BY THE LONG FEATHERS OF HIS TAIL WITH RIGHT HAND, WHILE HOLDING THE BASE OF THE LIMB ON WHICH HE SITS, IN THE LEFT, PULL UPWARD ON THE TAIL AND SEE HIM WAKE UP. YOU CAN ALMOST HEAR HIM YELL FOR A CRACK
